These workshops are designed for anyone involved in evacuation planning, mass care, or sheltering in place: medical facilities, long-term care facilities, EMS, public health agencies, Tribes, emergency managers, state and local planning agencies, veterinarians, fire and police services, aging, social and mental health services, prisons, schools, volunteer agencies, faith based groups involved in disaster relief, and advocates for special needs populations.

COUNTY REPRESENTATIVES MEET THE PLAN WRITERS

- Schedule an appointment to meet with the plan writers of the evacuation plan to learn more about the planning process and give input regarding local concerns and issues

SPECIAL NEEDS POPULATIONS COURSE

- Hazard mitigation strategies to protect clients and facilities

ANIMALS IN DISASTERS COURSE

- Animal rescue techniques
- Temporary sheltering of animals during evacuations
- Triage of animals during emergencies
- Pet identification tools
